Using web-based tools and person-centered approaches, the BECs help **low-income seniors and persons with disabilities** find and enroll in all the benefits programs for which they are eligible, and create coordinated, community wide systems of benefits access.

BECs also help seniors and adults with disabilities to apply for other programs, such as Supplemental Security Income (SSI), State Pharmaceutical Assistance Programs, local transportation assistance, tax relief and more.

A brief application process provides a printed report of benefits you qualify for as well as how to apply.

BRIDGES now has a benefits enrollment center.

Our BEC is part of the Nation Council on Aging (NCOA) network dedicated to helping low-income, Medicare eligible seniors and persons with disabilities to identify and apply for benefits programs.

BRIDGES' BEC provides help to eligible residents in Rockland County.
